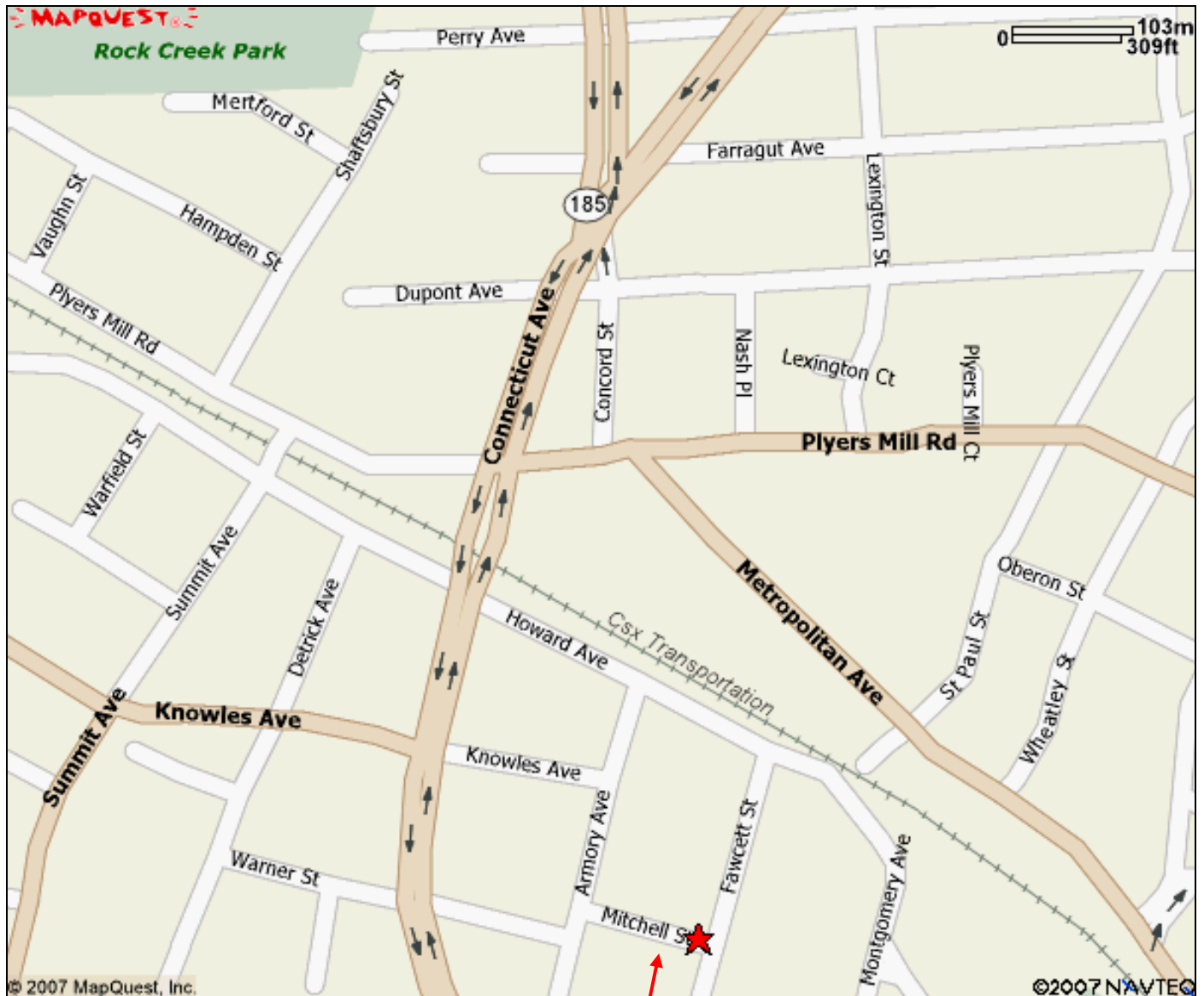


Map and Directions to Montgomery Municipal Cable Channel 16 Studio

MMC TV Channel 16 is located in Kensington, MD. The studio is on the **basement floor** of the Kensington town hall/armory, **at the rear of the building**.

Directions

(From as many different perspectives as we can consider)



(From all directions...once you are on Knowles Ave.)

Go one block to the stop sign. Turn right onto Armory Ave. Go one block to the stop sign. Turn left onto Mitchell St. Halfway up the block, turn right into the armory parking lot. The armory looks like a brick castle. Park. Go DOWNSTAIRS on the outside steps. Go through the heavy green doors. The studio is in the back, on the left side of the hallway. If the studio door is closed, taping is most likely in progress.

(If you travel Connecticut Ave. Northbound towards Montgomery County MD, from DC or I-495)

Enter the Kensington antique district on Connecticut Ave. Pass the “Kensington” sign (on the right).

At Knowles Ave., turn right onto Knowles. (*Continue at A*)

(From I-495, the Capital Beltway)

Take the Connecticut Ave./Rt. MD-185 exit.

Go North on Connecticut Ave.

At Knowles Ave., turn right onto Knowles. (*Continue at A*)

(From Washington, DC)

Get to Chevy Chase Circle and onto Connecticut Ave./Rt. MD-185 Northbound. (You have to figure out how to do that!)

Go North on Connecticut Ave. for quite a distance.

Warning: Travel the speed limit just out of the circle, between Irving and Lennox. The Chevy Chase police are merciless on speeders.

Major streets you will cross traveling Northbound on Connecticut:

- Bradley Lane (at Chevy Chase Country Club).
- You will pass the 4-H Conference Center (on the left) in Bethesda.
- East-West Highway (MD-410).
- Jones Bridge Road.
- I-495 (Capital Beltway).

At Knowles Ave., turn right onto Knowles. (*Continue at A*)

(From Columbia MD)

Time estimates → “rush hour” mornings = 1 hour, 30 minutes; “rush hour” evenings = 1 hour, 10 minutes; off hours = 1 hour.

Take MD-29/Columbia Pike Southbound.

In Burtonsville, MD exit right onto MD-198/Spencerville Rd.

Take MD-198 West until it crosses MD-650/New Hampshire Ave.

Cross over MD-650 and continue straight onto MD-28/Norbeck Rd.

- In other words, MD-198 turns into MD-28.

Follow Norbeck Rd. – forever, it seems – to MD-97/Georgia Ave.

Turn left onto MD-97/Georgia Ave.

Follow Georgia Ave. to MD-185/Connecticut Ave.

- Home Depot is on the right; Gate of Heaven Cemetary is on the left at Connecticut Ave.

Bear right onto Connecticut Ave.

Follow Connecticut Ave. Southbound (towards DC) into the town of Kensington.

Enter the Kensington antique district on Connecticut Ave.

- Pass the fire station (on the right @ Plyers Mill Rd.).

At Knowles Ave., get into the left-turn lane and turn left onto Knowles. (*Continue at **A***)

(From North and East of Columbia, MD → that's Baltimore vicinity and beyond)

You've got to figure out how to get to MD-29 / Columbia Pike Southbound! Major roads with MD-29 exits, in Southbound order:

- I-70.
- MD-40 (Baltimore National Pike).
- MD-144 (Frederick Rd.)
- MD-108 (Clarksville Pike / Old Annapolis Rd.)
- MD-175.
- Broken Land Parkway.
- MD-32.
- Johns Hopkins Rd.
- MD-216.

Once you hit Burtonsville, exit MD-29 at MD-198 (West).

Follow the directions (*From Columbia, MD*) above.

(From I-95)

Bail-out at Exit 33, MD-198/Sandy Spring Rd.

Follow MD-198 to MD-29.

Cross over MD-29 and continue following the directions (*From Columbia, MD*) above.
